

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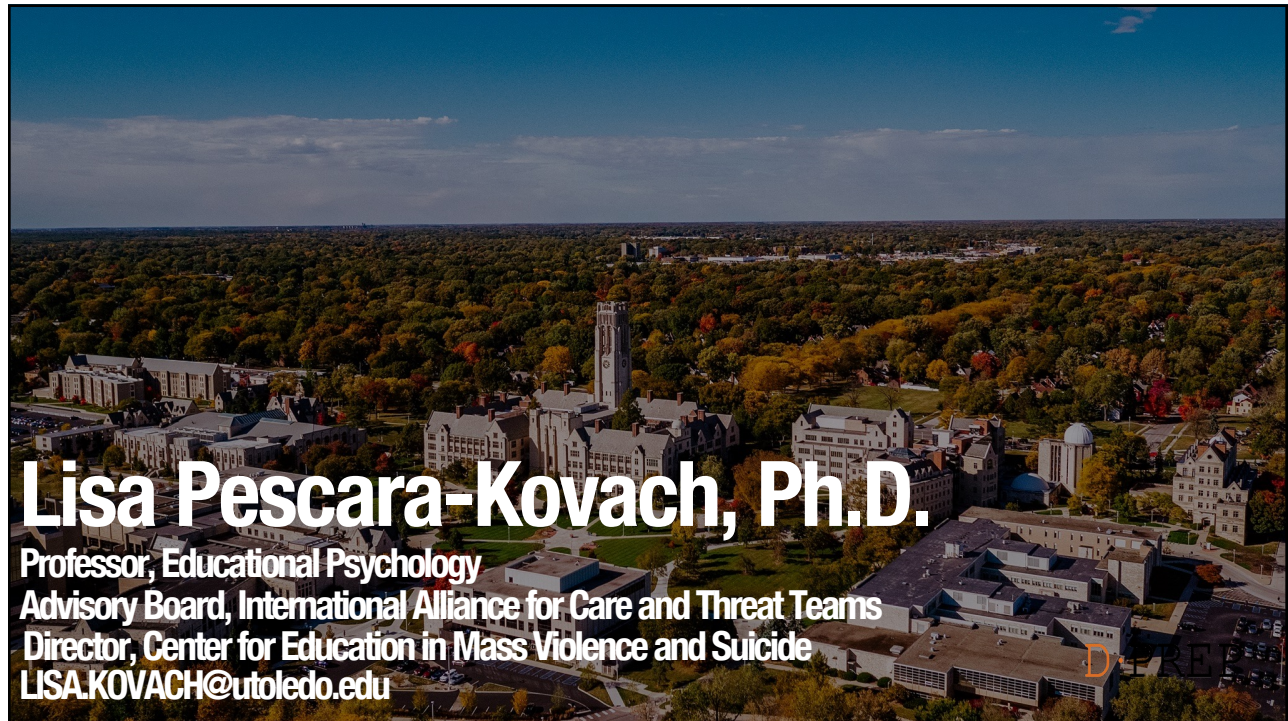

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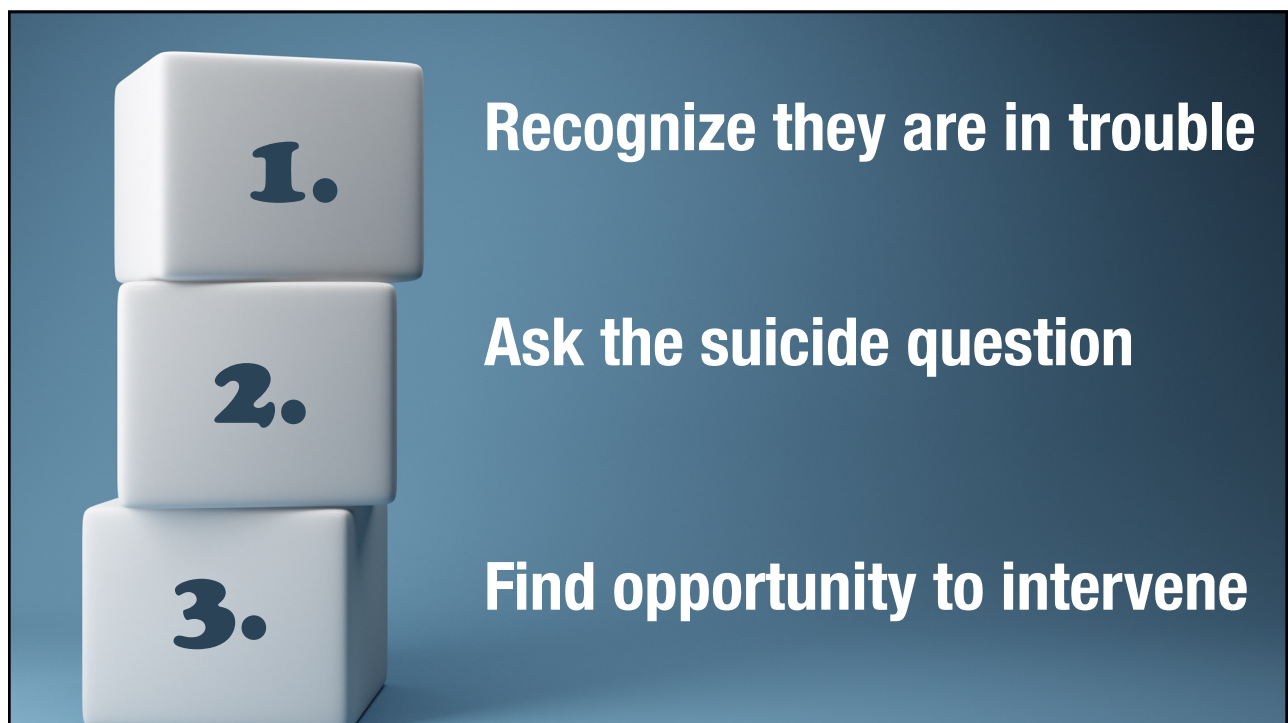

- 988 accepts calls from anyone who needs support for a suicidal, mental health and/or substance use crisis.



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
AFTER A SUICIDE

CLUSTER	CONTAGION	PACT
Consecutive suicides among members of a peer group.	Exposure to a suicide death may lead others to contemplate suicide.	An agreement by 2+ individuals to die by suicide.

According to the [CDC](#), Adolescents and young adults are most susceptible to contagion.

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
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PREVENTING CONTAGION AFTER A SUICIDE

- Acknowledge the suicide without providing information on the means or speculation on why it happened.
- Check in regularly with those close to the student and those previously struggling with their mental health.
- At-risk individuals may view suicide as a means to an end based on another individual's suicide.

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**MEDIA OUTLETS, SCHOOL/CAMPUS

**"A LOCAL, DEPRESSED STUDENT DECIDED THEIR
LIFE WASN'T WORTH LIVING, SO THEY PURCHASED
A ROPE, DRANK A BOTTLE OF VODKA, AND DIED BY
HANGING."**

WHAT TO SAY:
**"THERE WAS A SUICIDE IN OUR SCHOOL
YESTERDAY."**
